### Delivery Mode

Face to face workshops occur two days each week. Assessment tasks including assignments, in addition to workshops, will be required to complete this qualification. This course is deemed as full-time study.

### Entry Requirements

Whilst there are no pre-requisites stated in the training package the sector requires you to achieve a Working with Vulnerable People Check and evidence of a full COVID vaccine (including booster) PRIOR to commencement of the program. You will also need to provide Current ID and have a genuine desire to work in this sector. A Language, Literacy and Numeracy assessment is also required to develop a support plan if necessary.
